Introduction:

- Grab the attention of the audience for example, a shocking fact.
- Explain what your speech is about briefly.

Main body- paragraph 1:

- What is your first argument for or against climate change?
- This should be the strongest argument.

Main body- paragraph 2:

- What is your second argument for or against climate change?

Main body- paragraph 3:

- What is your third argument for or against climate change?
- This could be your undermine paragraph to explain why some people think enough is being done to stop climate change.

Conclusion:

- Summarise your arguments as the last attempt to convince your audience.
