EXPRESSIVE ARTS

TASK: Blitz Soundscape
Create a soundscape using household items to represent the sounds of the Blitz (e.g., sirens, bombs, footsteps). Record or perform it for your family.

HEALTH & WELL-BEING

 **TASK: Fire-Themed Mindfulness.**

Imagine a calming campfire.
Draw it and write 5 things you see, hear, smell, and feel. Then sit quietly and breathe deeply for 2 minutes.
Share how it made you feel.

HUMANITIES

 **Task: Compare Firefighters Then and Now**
Research how firefighters worked during the Great Fire of London vs. today. Create a Venn diagram or write a short comparison.

LANGUAGES, LITERACY & COMMUNICATION

 **Task: Write a short story beginning with:**
"As the smoke curled through the sky, a shadow moved... it was a dragon!"
Use exciting adjectives and describe the setting.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

 **Task: Build a Fireproof House (LEGO or junk modelling)**
Design and build a house that could survive a fire. Think about materials and structure. Take a photo and explain your choices.

DIGITAL

 **Task: Dragon Fact File**
Research different types of dragons from myths or stories. Write a short fact file including:

- Where they live
- What they eat
- Special powers
- Draw your dragon too!

MATHEMATICS

TASK: Dragon's Treasure
A dragon guards 5,430 or 453 gold coins.

- How many hundreds are in this number?
- What happens to the number if the 3 is moved to the thousands/hundreds place?

Create your own maths problem:

- Create your own 3/4-digit fire-themed number.
- Write it in words
- Break it into thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones
- Explain what each digit is worth

Learn how to say hello to answer the register in another language.
