EXPRESSIVE ARTS

Create a short fire-inspired dance or movement sequence to music. Think about how flames flicker, spread, and die down. Show it to a family member.

HEALTH & WELL-BEING

 Task: Imagine you are a firefighter after a long day. Write or draw 3 ways you would relax and look after your wellbeing after such a stressful job.

HUMANITIES

 Task: Research a famous fire in history (like the Great Fire of London or a local one). Draw a quick timeline showing 4-5 key events.

LANGUAGES, LITERACY & COMMUNICATION

 Task: Write a short poem called "Blaze of Glory". Try to use powerful adjectives, similes, or metaphors to describe fire.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

 Task: Find out what three things a fire needs to burn (the "Fire Triangle"). Draw and label the triangle with your own colourful design.

DIGITAL

 Task: Use a free drawing app or a simple paint programme to create a "fire safety poster". If you don't have access, sketch it on paper and imagine it's online.

WELSH LANGUAGE

 Task: Learn and use 5 Welsh words linked to fire (e.g. tân = fire, mwg = smoke). Make a mini wordlist or use them in a simple sentence.

ENTREPRENEURIAL

Cross-cutting Creativity / Enterprise (Blended AoLEs)

 Task: Invent a "Super Firefighting Gadget" that could help in a blaze. Draw it, label the parts, and explain in a few sentences how it works.
