We have received thanks from Matts Café following the Warm and Woolly service we had in Christchurch Church in February. Matts Café were delighted to receive the kind donations, from the children and staff in Christchurch and St. Helens Primary Schools.



We are very proud of the strong links and collaboration we have with St. Helen's Primary School, in particular the pupil led initiatives we have shared together recently and have future plans for.

Last term pupils from St. Helen's Primary school were invited by the pupils, to Christchurch on two occasions.
