



Fusion After School Club

To all children and parents at Christchurch Primary,

We're excited to launch the new Fusion Club! It's going to take place on a Wednesday after school, from 3.20 to 4.30pm. We will have two groups - **Anchors** (Reception to Y2) and **Juniors** (Y3-6). The clubs will be run by staff and volunteers from Christ Church and St James Church, and be led by Sherry Tanagho (Children and Family worker) and Rev Ian. We will start on Weds 8th November.

The programme will be based on resources from the Boys Brigade/Girls Association. This means that there will be a fun, high quality programme, which will help to develop life skills and experiences. Like Cubs and Brownies, children work towards badges in different areas: Get Active; Get Adventurous; Get Creative; Get into the Bible; Get Involved, and Get Learning. We'll be doing crafts, music, sports and games. The club is run by the churches and includes faith based activities, but all are welcome to join.

In order to cover running costs and fees for Boys Brigade, we do need to charge for the club. Initially this will be £15 per term (or £7.50 per half term), which we are subsidising from other budgets. All staff and volunteers are DBS checked and receive training by the Boys Brigade.

We will have an information meeting for **parents** and children on **Thursday 26th October directly after school**. You will need to fill in a form to register your child for the group.

We look forward to getting the clubs started, and having fun together!
